## Nursery arrangements for January 2021

I am writing to tell you the arrangements for January, following the Scottish Government's announcement of a delay to the restart of schools and nurseries in January.

**Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> January** – <u>nursery closed to all children</u>. Staff will be planning reopening and discussing home activity resources for families

**Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> January** to **Friday 15<sup>th</sup> January** – <u>nursery closed to all children **except** keyworkers</u> <u>families</u> and those families in need of additional support (see below for more information)

## Monday 18<sup>th</sup> January – we expect to open as normal

The Scottish Government guidance states that "the purpose of these restrictions is to reduce households mixing as far as possible in order to suppress the virus and take firm preventative measures, particularly in light of the new strain of COVID-19 identified." For this reason, it is only right that we expect to only have a very small number of children in for nursery attendance before 18<sup>th</sup> January. The Scottish Government have published some general guidance on what "keyworker" means, and about other families who may be in need of support: <u>https://www.gov.scot/publications/coronavirus-covid-19-childcare-provision-from-26-december-to-18-january/pages/vulnerable-children/</u> Those families where there is a parent or other relative at home, even if they are working from home, would **not** normally be eligible to attend between 6<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> January. I will make contact in the next couple of days with the small number of families who I expect to be eligible to attend nursery before January 18th.

Between 6<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> January we will provide some play and learning materials and suggestions that you can use at home, both with books and materials to collect but also online materials (Twitter feed is @renfrewstreet). It will also be a priority of mine to contact all families once staff return from 5<sup>th</sup> January.
