

Our main improvement priorities this year (Sep 2019 to June 2020) are:

1 - Update of the nursery's vision, values and aims, in consultation with staff, parents, carers and children with a focus on learning and developmental progress.

This will involve consultation with parents, children and the staff team about what is important and distinctive at Renfrew St, including some staff development work enhancing our knowledge of theory into practice and child development . This will then be captured in our new vision, values and aims and day to day practice will develop and improve.

The Language and Communication Friendly Establishment program will involve staff training and support from speech and language therapy, and involvement of other support services such as Educational Psychology and English as Additional Language Service.

3 - Carefully manage the process of change in extending the nursery hours (to 1140 hours entitlement) whilst maintaining a high quality service, a consistent approach to learning, consistent routine and equitable provision for children and families.

Consistent development, consultation and discussion through the year to manage the change to extended hours without disruption to the quality of service we offer.

2 - Improve children's language development, including the involvement of parents and carers, through starting the journey to become an accredited Language and Communication Friendly Establishment (LCFE)
